- 3. A minimum 2.5 GPA cumulative GPA on a weighted 4.0 scale. Though we encourage students with a cumulative G.P.A. of 2.5 or higher to apply for our scholarship, we will accept applications from any student who has demonstrated strong leadership skills and a record of community service. - 6. (2) Recommendation Letters
 - a. A completed teacher evaluator form (included in scholarship packet)
 - b. A character reference letter from a community member (cannot be a relative of the applican).
